AUGUST, DOB: 3/23/60, hereinafter called the defendant, on or about JUNE 7, 2004, in the County of Lake and State of Illinois, committed the offense of AGGRAVATED BATTERY, in that the said defendant, in committing a battery, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-3, knowingly made physical contact of an insulting nature with caused bodily harm to Deputy Amber, of the Lake County Sheriff's Department, in that the said defendant broke Deputy Amber's hand, knowing Deputy Amber to be a peace officer engaged in the execution of his official duties, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-4(b)(6); contrary to the form of the Statutes in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the People of the State of Illinois.

Count 2. That the Grand Jurors chosen, selected and sworn, in and for the County of Lake, in the State of Illinois, having been duly recalled, in the name and by authority of the People of the State of Illinois, upon their oaths present that CHARLES A. AUGUST, DOB: 3/23/60, hereinafter called the defendant, on or about JUNE 7, 2004, in the County of Lake and State of Illinois, committed the offense of RESISTING A PEACE OFFICER, in that the said defendant knowingly resisted the performance of Deputy Amber, of an authorized act within his official capacity, being the arrest of said defendant, knowing Deputy Amber to be a peace officer engaged in the execution of his official duties, in that said defendant struggled with Deputy Amber, and is so doing, said defendant caused injury to Deputy Amber, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/31-1(a-7); contrary to the form of the Statutes in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the People of the State of Illinois.
