On the date of this report at 9:33 PM I was dispatched to an address of [REDACTED] or a Domestic Dispute involving the complainant [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Dispatch initially informed me that the situation was verbal only at the time and that [REDACTED] was intoxicated. While enroute to the residence dispatch informed me that [REDACTED] advised them that [REDACTED] left the residence in [REDACTED] car and [REDACTED] had a handgun in [REDACTED] possession. [REDACTED] told dispatch that [REDACTED] physically saw the weapon in [REDACTED] possession as [REDACTED] pulled out of the garage. [REDACTED] also informed dispatch that [REDACTED] was on [REDACTED] way to Deerfield to shoot [REDACTED] boss. The address and subject [REDACTED] was on [REDACTED] way to see was a [REDACTED]. An ISPERN was immediately put out with the vehicle information and offender information on [REDACTED]. District 2 Deputies Struck and McNicho then went down to the Walnut address to speak with [REDACTED] and to make [REDACTED] aware of the situation.

Upon arrival at [REDACTED] address on [REDACTED] to gather more information I was informed by dispatch that [REDACTED] had returned home and was in an upstairs bedroom. I then waited down the street for Wauconda Police units to arrive to provide me with some assistance before going to the residence. Myself along with Wauconda Officers Marcelo Candia and Darius Adams then arrived at the [REDACTED] address and approached the front door. A [REDACTED] subject [REDACTED] approached the door and as [REDACTED] did I had my service weapon out of the holster aimed at [REDACTED] not knowing if [REDACTED] was the offender [REDACTED] or not. Other family members including [REDACTED] then informed us that [REDACTED] was not the offender and that [REDACTED] was in the upstairs master bedroom.

Myself along with the two Wauconda officers then stood at the bottom of the stairwell leading to the upper level where the master bedroom was located with our weapons out and pointed at the upstairs landing where [REDACTED] would have to approach from. [REDACTED] was verbally commanded several times to come out into the hallway with [REDACTED] hands up in the air where we could see them to observe that [REDACTED] still did not possess a weapon. After those several commands [REDACTED] then walked out of the bedroom into the hallway (landing). [REDACTED] did not have [REDACTED] hands in the air as directed and they were in fact at [REDACTED] sides near his thighs where they were not entirely visible. Myself along with the Wauconda officers then began yelling at [REDACTED] to show us [REDACTED] hands and put them in the air. [REDACTED] ignored our commands and continued to advance towards us and began walking down the stairs with [REDACTED] hands still not visible. [REDACTED] began to yell as [REDACTED] approached us "Get the fuck out of my house" "What the fuck are you doing in my house". [REDACTED] continued to advance down the stairs ignoring our commands to stop and show [REDACTED] hands. [REDACTED] then stated "Go ahead and shoot me" as [REDACTED] continued to come down the stairs. As [REDACTED] approached the second to last step I was then able to see [REDACTED] hands and did not identify a

weapon in those hands but was still unsure if [REDACTED] may have a weapon on [REDACTED] person. I then holstered my weapon and at that point [REDACTED] was now at the bottom of the stairwell face to face with me. I immediately grabbed [REDACTED] about the body in an attempt to get [REDACTED] down to the ground and secure him to eliminate any possible threat and continue my investigation. [REDACTED] then began to resist my efforts to contain [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was taken down to the floor of the dining room with the assistance of the Wauconda officers. Once on the floor [REDACTED] continued to resist as we attempted to handcuff [REDACTED] and ignored our commands to stop resisting and comply. During the scuffle all officers were on top of [REDACTED] as [REDACTED] lay on the floor on his stomach. Charles tucked his arms underneath himself and all efforts to get [REDACTED] hands behind [REDACTED] back were unsuccessful. As we struggled with [REDACTED] I heard [REDACTED] screaming "Gun, Gun!!" I then observed a black Beretta semi-automatic handgun laying on the floor next to [REDACTED]. I was able to retrieve the weapon and I slid it across the floor into an adjoining room out of the reach of [REDACTED]. We then continued to struggle with [REDACTED] and at some point one of the Wauconda officers utilized his pepper spray on [REDACTED]. The spray had no immediate affect and [REDACTED] continued to resist, [REDACTED] then got to [REDACTED] knees and as [REDACTED] was taken back down to the floor [REDACTED] landed directly on top of me. I then began to use the heel of my left foot to strike [REDACTED] in the back to gain compliance. After several strikes Wauconda Officers were able to get [REDACTED] hands behind [REDACTED] back and I was able to slide out from underneath him. I then handcuffed [REDACTED] and after several minutes of rest [REDACTED] was escorted to the back seat of my patrol car. I then learned that the weapon on the floor of the dining room belonged to one of the Wauconda officers who was not able to secure it in his holster as the struggle began.

With a consent to search the bedroom by [REDACTED] Wauconda officers located a loaded Rohm Gmbh .22 magnum handgun on an upper shelf in the bedroom. Kimberly identified this as being the weapon [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] leave the residence with. A second unloaded Pats. April .22 handgun was located in a paper bag in a top dresser drawer. Both weapons were made safe by this deputy and have been retained. The weapons will be sent to the crime lab for testing and then returned to the Sheriff's office and will not be returned to [REDACTED] without a court order.

[REDACTED] then spoke to [REDACTED] about the events that led up to the call for police. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both stated that they along with [REDACTED] were out on the deck after supper having a discussion. [REDACTED] then report that [REDACTED] grew agitated and began to demand that [REDACTED] "tell them the truth". [REDACTED] allegedly believes that [REDACTED] is having an affair with [REDACTED] boss [REDACTED], previously mentioned in this report. [REDACTED] then told [REDACTED] that if [REDACTED] put a gun in [REDACTED] mouth [REDACTED] would get the truth. [REDACTED] then report that [REDACTED] went into the house and downstairs into the basement where [REDACTED] keeps a steel gunsafe. [REDACTED] did not go downstairs

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with [redacted] and are not sure what [redacted] did down there. [redacted] then walked out of the house.

[redacted] also reports the same discussion on the deck and the comment that [redacted] made about the [redacted] also reports that [redacted] went down to the basement. As [redacted] walked out into the garage [redacted] reports that [redacted] demanded [redacted] come with [redacted] and at this point [redacted] states [redacted] law [redacted] opening in the waistband of [redacted] shorts and identified it as being the previously mentioned handgun. [redacted] refused to go with [redacted] and then went into the house and called the Sheriff's Dept.

[redacted] was transported to the Lake Co. Jail by Deputy Jose Favela who spoke with the state's attorney and charges of aggravated battery and resisting a peace officer were approved. Written statements will be obtained by Deputy Favela from [redacted] This reporting deputy was transported to [redacted] Hospital by Wauconda rescue with a broken left hand resulting from the struggle/resistance by [redacted] No further action taken at this time.
